Working Bees: Recent Working bees have been involved in clearing deadwood cutting back growth along the pathway and and preparing areas suitable for planting for National Tree day and the remaining working bees this year. Some of the wattle trees planted 8 - 10 years ago are reaching their age limits and a couple close to the pathway had to be removed.

Overall the creek plantings close to the Riversdale end are beginning to mature and in filling planting of spaces will be soon required.

National Tree day:

FOBC will have 1500 seedlings to plant on National Tree day Sunday 29th July. We will start as usual at 10:00 am - 12:00 pm. Families are invited to come along and register at the Quinton Rd site. Bring some digging equipment, warm clothes, gloves and firm shoes or boots. We are expecting between 50 - 70 participants. At the end of the planting Council will be providing a BBQ at the Quinton Rd Site.

Schools Tree Day

On Friday 27th July FOBC will be participating in Schools Tree Day with Wattle Park Primary School and Boroondara Council. We plan to plant over 800 seedlings involving nearly 250 school children. At the end the children will receive cup cakes and cordial.

For both Schools Tree Day and National tree day the planting will take place along the pathway south of Cornell Street towards Lynden Park. In particular planting will be done along the fence boundary to the Realm housing development next to the pathway.

Our committee member Eleanor Stephenson yurned 90 years old in June. You may see her along the pathway conducting bird sightings. Eleaner was a founding member of FOBC and continues to assist with sweeping the boardwalk during working bees. Congratulations Eleanor.

Residential Weeds:

Much of the work FOBC does in preparing the creek for planting starts with weed removal. Most weed species found along the creek have come from either transportation of seeds by birds or wind or water along the creek. Other weeds come from grass cuttings or rubbish dumped by residents.

Arum Lilies, Ginger, Wondering dew, Ivy, Nasturtiums, Jasmine, Morning glory are the common names of just some of the weed species that can be found down the creek. These weeds are insidious and hard to contain and quickly colonise and take over any cleared ground. Strategies FOBC employs to ensure they do not resurface include use of Jute Matting, and intensive planting of native ground cover species and grasses. Council backs this up with strategic use of spraying on particular weed species.
